

BY-LAW 30-71

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH
TO AUTHORIZE FORMATION OF
AN ANTHROPOLOGICAL AND CULTURAL SOCIETY

The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith in the Northwest Territories, in regular meeting, duly assembled enacts as follows:


1. That the Council's solicitors be instructed to incorporate a society under the provisions of the Societies Ordinance of the Northwest Territories, such society to be named Northern Anthropological and Cultural Society, or such other name as may appear appropriate to the Council and with such objects as are appropriate to the concept of a museum having regard to the informal agreement reached between his Excellency Bishop Piche and Councillor Darrell Clarkson, Committee Chairman, as previously laid before the Council.
2. This By-Law shall come into force and take effect with the third reading thereof.

Read a first time this 21st day of December, 1971.

Read a second time this 21st day of December, 1971.

Read a third time this 21st day of December, 1971, finally passed with the unanimous consent of those Councillors present, signed by the Mayor and the Secretary-Treasurer and the Corporate Seal affixed thereto.
