

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH

BYLAW #751

A BYLAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO PROVIDE FOR REMUNERATION TO THE MEMBERS OF COUNCIL, PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 34 OF THE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGES ACT BEING CHAPTER C-8 OF THE R.S.N.W.T. 1988.

AS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, in the Northwest Territories, deems it to be in the public interest to establish rates of remuneration for the Mayor, Deputy Mayor and Councillors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

1. The Mayor of the Town of Fort Smith shall receive:
  - (1) An honorarium as per the scale outlined in "Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this bylaw, in accordance with the following method;
    - (a) A newly appointed Mayor shall be paid an honorarium equal to year one (1) of the honorarium scale.
    - (b) Subject to Council resolution and yearly review, the Mayor's honorarium may be increased by one increment level.
  - (2) An annual vacation with pay of four (4) weeks. If the Mayor is absent on vacation for a period of more than four (4) weeks in any calendar year, the Mayor shall be deducted an amount proportionate to the number of days in excess of four (4) weeks.
  - (3) Benefits as outlined in Schedule "B" attached to and forming part of this bylaw;
2. The Deputy-Mayor shall receive an annual honorarium of \$6,400.00 (Six Thousand Four Hundred Dollars);
3. Each Councillor, other than the Deputy-Mayor, shall receive an annual honorarium of \$4,800.00 (Four Thousand Eight Hundred Dollars).
4. Each member of Council, other than the Mayor and Deputy Mayor shall receive a per diem allowance of \$100.00 (One Hundred Dollars) when required to be on Town business as stipulated by resolution of Town Council. All members of Council shall be reimbursed for travel expenses while on Town business at rates equal to those paid to Municipal Employees.
5. Payment of the honorarium shall be bi-weekly to the Mayor and monthly to Councillors.
6. (1) The position of Mayor shall be considered as part-time and the incumbent shall work a minimum of four office hours per working day.
7. Bylaw #643 is hereby repealed.



8. Honorariums referred to in Section 1, 2, and 3 shall be deemed to contain an expense allowance of one third of the honorarium.
9. When a member of Council is absent from a duly scheduled regular or special meeting of Council or the scheduled monthly Committee of the Whole meeting, that Councillor's monthly honorarium shall be reduced by \$100 (One Hundred Dollars) per missed meeting.

**SCHEDULE "B"**

**BENEFITS**

The benefits referred to in subsection (3) of this Bylaw which shall be paid to the Mayor of Fort Smith during his term of office are as follows:

- a. Participation in the Group Life Accidental Death and Dismemberment, Long Term Disability Insurance Plan, and the Dental and Medical Plan.
