#### b. NTPC Intervention

i. NTPC Intervention Committee Minutes January 29<sup>th</sup>, 2024 – The minutes were reviewed. Cr. Couvrette provided a review of the minutes and advised that Stand Alone Energy has been representing the Town's interests regarding the Hay River power distribution sale from NUL to NTPC to ensure Fort Smith ratepayers are negatively impacted.

Cr. Couvrette suggested a letter be sent to the PUB expressing concern that NTPC may try to capitalize on diesel costs during the Talston Expansion Project shutdown. He noted that if diesel costs are capitalized, potentially \$10 million would be charged back to the rate base with an additional 8% return on investment.

## **BRIEFING NOTE**

To: Corporate Services Standing Committee

Date: March 5, 2024

Subject: 2024 Capital Plan Updated Priorities

#### **Purpose:**

To present the 2024 Capital Plan.

#### Background:

In January 2023 Council approved the 2023 5-year Capital Investment Plan (CIP). This Plan identified 45 capital projects to be undertaken in 2023 using forms provided by the GNWT.

In July 2023 Council approved a 2023 Capital Project Update which used a Project Substantiation sheet for each project and a Priority Matrix to prioritize projects. This initiative reduced the number for projects for 2023 to 33.

The draft 2024 Capital Plan used the modified 2023 Capital Project Update as a base, removing any completed projects and adding any new projects required for 2024. The new projects have Project Substantiation sheets and are incorporated into the original Priority Matrix. Projects currently underway are identified to ensure work can continue, and evergreen projects are also captured.

February 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024, Council reviewed the presented priorities list. Discussions centered around the need to continue with projects already initiated, and to focus additional projects for 2024 on public health and safety, specifically those related to wildfire preparedness and winter power outages.

Note that project management is a specific skillset that requires extensive time requirements, and that would excessively tax the capacity of current Town HR resources. The consequences of errors, especially with large-value projects, can result in high costs to the Town that are ultimately paid by the taxpayer. The Town will utilize external project management support that understands municipal requirements and the municipal operating environment where required. Capital funds can be used to pay for external project management services, reducing pressure on Administration and the O&M Budget.

Finally, there is no deadline for completion of the 2024 Capital Plan. While the GNWT requires that the 2024 O&M Budget be approved by February 29, 2024, there are no requirements for Capital Plan completion. Further, the 2023 Capital Project Update was only approved approximately six months ago and is still a valid document; Town staff continue to work diligently to manage the many projects which have resulted from the 2023 Capital Project Update. The revised Capital Plan Priorities List presents the full list of required and desired projects identified in the 2023 and 2024 Capital Plan project updates, however, the proposed capital plan to be approved for 2024 includes only the first 25 listed projects, identified by the red numbers.

The 2024 20-year Long-term Capital Plan (presented via separate Briefing Note on February 12, 2024) will require revision once the prioritization exercise is complete, and the 2024 Capital Plan approved.

#### Recommendation:

That the 2024 Capital Plan be approved as presented.
