

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, N. W. T.

By-Law 2-77

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH TO REGULATE THE STORAGE OF GASOLINE AND OTHER FLAMMABLE AND COMBUSTIBLE LIQUIDS IN AND ON RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 175(f) OF THE MUNICIPAL ORDINANCE, BEING CHAPTER M-15 OF THE REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES 1974 AS AMENDED

WHEREAS Council may pass by-laws establishing measures for the prevention of fires;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

- 1) This by-law shall apply to the storage of gasoline and other flammable and combustible liquids in buildings classified as residential occupancies.
- 2) No person shall store more than one (1) gallon of flammable liquid having a flash point of 37.5° celsius or less in a dwelling unit.
- 3) No person shall store in excess of twenty-five (25) gallons of a flammable liquid having a flash point of 37.5° celsius or less on a property in an R1, R2, R3, or T zone.
- 4) All containers used for the storage of a flammable liquid having a flash point below 37.5° celsius shall be approved by the Fire Chief or by the Deputy Fire Chief of the Town of Fort Smith.
- 5) Failure to comply with any of the requirements of this by-law shall constitute an offense under the by-law punishable upon summary conviction to a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars (\$100) or One (1) Month in jail or both.

READ a SECOND TIME this 15th day of FEBRUARY, 1977.

READ a THIRD TIME this 15th day of FEBRUARY, 1977
and passed with the unanimous consent of all Councillors present.
