A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES,
TO AMEND THE TRAFFIC REGULATION BYLAW 616,
PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 70 AND 73 OF THE CITIES, TOWNS
AND VILLAGES ACT S.N.W.T. 2003, c.22

WHEREAS, the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, in the Northwest Territories, deems there is a need for the placement of 4-way traffic control devices at the intersection of Calder Avenue and Breynat Street and at the intersection of Calder Avenue and Wilderness Road, and

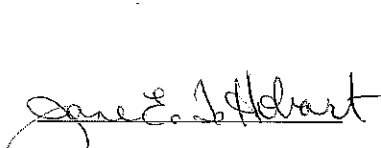
NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

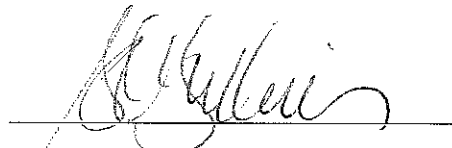
1. That 4-way traffic control stop signage be placed at the intersection of Calder Avenue and Breynat Street to ensure that traffic will stop at the intersection.
2. That 4-way traffic control stop signage be placed at the intersection of Calder Avenue and Wilderness Street to ensure that traffic will stop at the intersection.

READ A FIRST TIME THIS 14 DAY OF July, 2010 A.D.

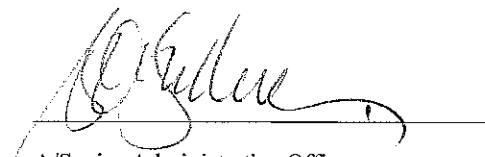
READ A SECOND TIME THIS 14 DAY OF July, 2010 A.D.
