THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH BY-LAW 890

A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO ADOPT THE 2012 BUDGET BYLAW, PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTIONS 70, 71 AND 72 OF THE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGE ACT S.N.W.T, 2003, c.22.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, in the Northwest Territories, deems it to be in the public interest to establish a 2012 Budget Bylaw for the operation and internal management of the municipal corporation;

AND WHEREAS the proposed revenues and expenditures have been reviewed;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows;

- 1. THAT the short title of the Bylaw may be cited as the "2012 Budget Bylaw."
- 2. THAT the estimates attached as Schedule "A" are hereby adopted and form part of this bylaw.
- 3. THAT any Bylaw or Bylaws, or parts of any Bylaw or Bylaws that are inconsistent with this Bylaw are hereby deemed repealed.
- 4. THAT this Bylaw shall come into force and effect on the date of its final passing.
- 5. THAT Bylaw 885 is hereby repealed.
