

TOWN OF FORT SMITH

BY-LAW NO. 814

BEING A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES TO ESTABLISH POLLING DIVISIONS PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 26 OF THE LOCAL AUTHORITIES ELECTION ACT S.N.W.T. 1988, c.L-10

WHEREAS, the Council of the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, in the Northwest Territories, deems it to be in the public interest to establish Polling Divisions;

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith in the Northwest Territories, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

1. This the Town of Fort Smith shall be divided into five (5) Polling Divisions for the purpose of Municipal Elections in accordance with the Local Authorities Elections Act.
2. That the established Polling Divisions are dependent on the population and may from time to time change as the population changes;
3. That Polling Division Number one (1) shall consist of all those electors residing within the municipal boundaries that have a surname beginning with the letter "A" of the alphabet to and including the letter "B";
4. That Polling Division Number two (2) shall consist of all those electors residing within the municipal boundaries that have a surname beginning with the letter "C" of the alphabet to and including the letter "G";
5. That Polling Division Number three (3) shall consist of all those electors residing within the municipal boundaries that have a surname beginning with the letter "H" of the alphabet to and including the letter "L";
6. That Polling Division Number four (4) shall consist of all those electors residing within the municipal boundaries that have a surname beginning with the letter "M" of the alphabet to and including the letter "Q";
7. That Polling Division Number five (5) shall consist of all those electors residing within the municipal boundaries that have a surname beginning with the letter "R" of the alphabet to and including the letter "Z";
8. Bylaw #266 is hereby repealed.
