

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH

BY-LAW 346

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO EXEMPT CERTAIN ASSESSED PROPERTIES FROM TAXATION PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 75 OF THE TAXATION ACT, BEING CHAPTER 18, 1987(1ST), OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES 1974

WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith, in the Northwest Territories, deems it necessary to exempt certain assessed properties from taxation;


NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

1. That museums be exempt from property taxation.
2. That churches and buildings owned by the Roman Catholic Episcopal Corporation, the Bishop of the Arctic, the Pentecostal Church, the King's Baptist Church and Les Peres Oblates which are used primarily for the purpose of public worship, and the contiguous land used in connection therewith, not exceeding 0.8 hectares, but not including any other buildings, not being churches or Sunday schools, erected on church property, be exempt from property taxation.
3. That By-Law # 114 is hereby repealed.
4. That the By-Law shall come into effect January 01, 1989.
