THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH

BY-LAW 642

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO PROVIDE FOR THE ADDRESS NUMBERING OF ALL RESIDENTIAL AND BUSINESS ESTABLISHMENTS PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 71(d) OF THE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGES ACT, BEING CHAPTER C-8, R.S.N.W.T., 1988

WHEREAS, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Fort Smith in the Northwest Territories, deems it to be in the public interest that all residential and business establishments have attached to the building a street address number.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting, enacts as follows:

- That the Town of Fort Smith shall assign street address numbers by lot and plan number.
- That the street address numbers assigned shall be listed on schedule "A" attached to and forming part of this Bylaw.
- 3. That the street address number plates shall be of a size not less than three (3) inches in height and placed on the front of the building as to be seen clearly from the roadway, and only the street address number, as assigned by the Town of Fort Smith, shall appear on the building.
- 4. That the placement and purchase of the street address numbers shall be the responsibility of the property owner and shall be placed on the existing building.
- That street address numbers shall be placed on newly constructed buildings on completion of the construction.
- 6. That every person who contravenes this Bylaw, is guilty of an offence, is liable to a fine not to exceed \$100.00 (one hundred dollars) on summary conviction.
- 7. That in lieu of prosecution, a voluntary fine of \$50.00 (fifty dollars) may be paid to the municipality.

- 8. This Bylaw shall come into full force and take effect upon third $(3^{\rm rd})$ reading thereof.
- 9. Bylaws #289 and #385 are hereby repealed.
