BY-LAW #498

A BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF FORT SMITH, IN THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES, TO ADOPT THE NATIONAL BUILDING CODE OF CANADA, PASSED PURSUANT TO SECTION 105 OF THE CITIES, TOWNS AND VILLAGES ACT, BEING CHAPTER C-8, 1988, OF THE REVISED STATUTES OF THE NORTHWEST TERRITORIES

WHEREAS, the Town of Fort Smith deems it to be in the public interest to rescind bylaw #27-68,

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Fort Smith, at a duly assembled meeting enacts as follows:

- That the Town of Fort Smith adopts the National Building Code of Canada as a code of standards for buildings, structures and excavations.
- 2. That Bylaw #27-68 is hereby rescinded.
